
Sous les yeux de La mère


Nyangwasu na munao

A series of paintings in tribute to a small rural town, Hueyapan located in the state of Morelos in northeastern Mexico, composed mainly of the Nahua ethnic group and its women who fought to be independent, to preserve their language (the Nahuatl) and their artisanal production of natural indigo dye, from the indigo plant to tint their outfits.

- The abyssal or abyssopelagic zone makes up the fourth part of the ocean floor which is between 4,000 and 6,000 meters deep. The texture represents the strong pressure of the water. Visually I wanted to make the appearance of water quite heavy and loaded.

Abstract representation inspired by the cosmos, of an unexpected emotional reaction, bliss.




